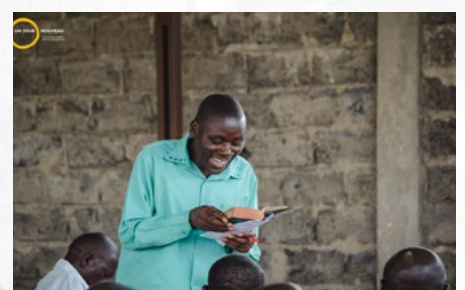


Training with the War Displaced People in Mugunga

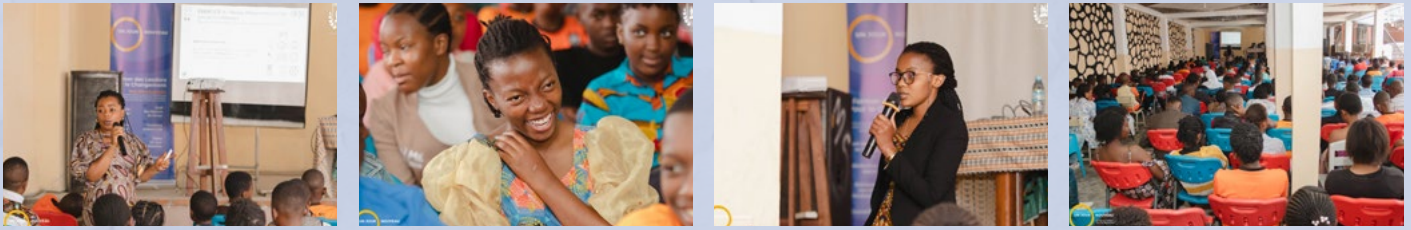


March 8 Conference with High School Leaders
