Mrs. Chantal Yelu Mulop Visits Un Jour Nouveau

Un Jour Nouveau was honored by a visit from the Special Advisor to the Head of State in charge of Youth and Combating Violence against Women, Her Excellency Madame Chantal Yelu Mulop, on Wednesday, September 6. Madame Chantal was on a mission to North Kivu, specifically Goma, and also visited around 300 women displaced by war in Mugunga and 50 others who were in a training called Spiritual Equipment for Healing Inner Wounds.



On Thursday, September 7, Madame Chantal met with a number of women entrepreneurs who had been trained by the Un Jour Nouveau HUB and Women of Congo Department. These women gave testimonies of success and also presented some of the challenges they face. To complete her visit, Madame Chantal presented 46 pieces of loincloth to the displaced, a gift from women working in the Kinshasa Civil Service.
